


The above constitutes a full and complete settlement of the above cited case and resolves any and all other related issues thereto. This settlement is not precedent setting and may not be cited in the future.



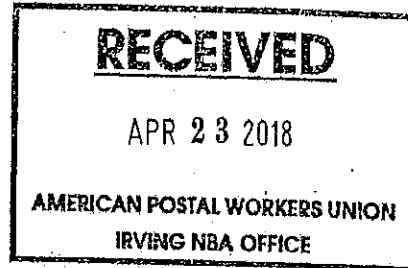


