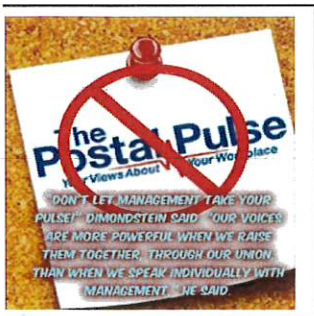

Don't Let the Postal Service Take your Pulse!



It is that time of the year when the Postal Service wants to take your pulse! Like previous years, the 2018 Postal Pulse survey showed the USPS what we already knew: Your work environment is not good; your supervisors treat you poorly and morale is low. The mean score changed by less than one-tenth of a point—suggesting nothing has changed at the Post Office.

One statistic that trended in the right direction in the APWU's opinion was employee participation in the survey. It went down from 46% in 2017 to 42% in 2018. **The APWU's goal is a zero-participation rate.**

The APWU implores you once again: ***Do not participate in the 2019 Postal Pulse Survey.*** You are probably being flooded with emails, postcards to your home, stand-up talks, posters on time clocks, and other tactics to try to get you to take the survey.
