The Senate is returning to DC on July 20th to take up legislation

Join us on Thursday, July 23rd

CALL Your U.S. Senators
ask them to provide **\$25 billion**
emergency stimulus funding
for the Postal Service

The House of Representatives has passed the HEROES Act which includes \$25 billion in COVID-19 related relief for the Postal Service as well as needed assistance for worker pensions, schools and local governments. The Senate is now working on passing their own relief bill and we need your help to build Senate support for S. 4174, The Postal Service Emergency Assistance Act, to make sure that this bill, which will provide USPS with \$25 billion, is included in the next Covid response package.



With your help, and the help of your coworkers, labor allies and community contacts, we can win this fight in defense of our jobs, our retirements, our union and the public Postal Service.

On July 23rd, join thousands of APWU members and our allies by dialing **844-402-1001** to connect with your Senators. You will be given the choice to speak to one of your two Senators. You must redial the hotline and follow the prompt to connect to your other Senator.

Know the Facts:

Yes, the call can be made on USPS property during non-working hours such as before or after work and during your breakeime or lunch hour.

Yes, non-postal workers can make the call. Ask your family, friends, neighbors, and community organizations to also call their Senators on July 23rd.

On July 23rd, Dial 844-402-1001 to be connected to your Senators. Urge them to co-sponsor S. 4174.
